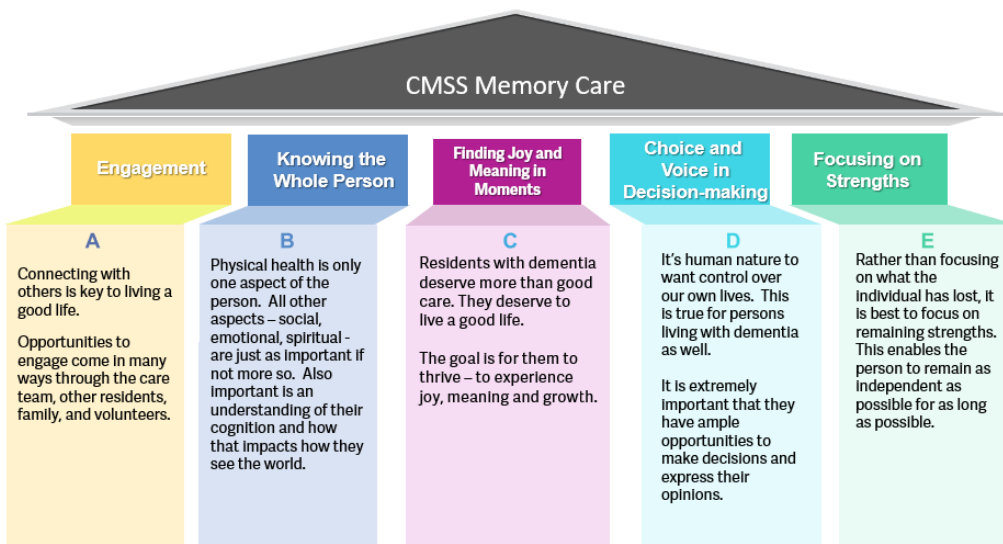
Our goal is to support residents to live a good life – to be engaged – to thrive.

These are some of our Life-Enhancing Programs:

- The Gathering Place – an onsite activity-based day program – opportunity to “go out for the day” without leaving the building
- Bringing Art to Life (BATL) – Yale University art therapists virtually join Wesley Place residents and a team of student volunteers for an interactive program of art appreciation
- ENGAGE – an extensive collection of one-to-one activities, designed to reach residents at all levels with family training
- Music and the Arts – dance, drama, music and art therapy - drumming circles – individualized music programs - performances by local artists
- Physical Fitness Classes - daily exercise classes to enhance, strength, balance, and overall endurance
- Resident-driven community service projects
